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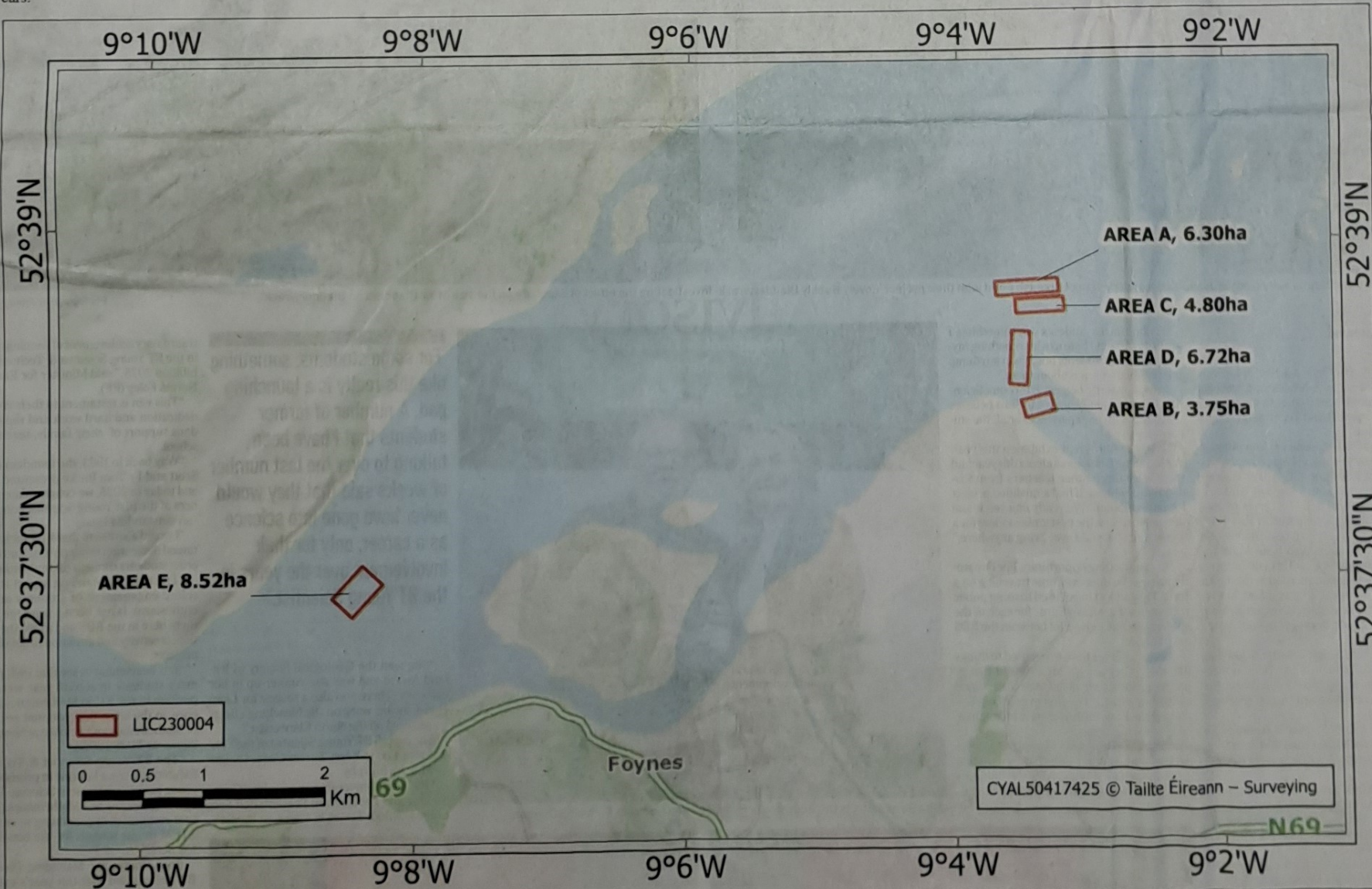

Invitation for public submissions on an application for a maritime usage licence and an appropriate assessment

Aughinish Alumina Ltd. submitted an application on 17th November 2023 to the Maritime Area Regulatory Authority ("MARA") for a maritime usage licence under section 117 of the Maritime Area Planning Act 2021 to undertake maintenance dredging at four sites around Aughinish Alumina Ltd. Jetty and the deposit (or dumping) of dredge material at a dump site off Foynes Island in the Shannon Estuary, Co. Limerick. The licence application is for a duration of 8 years.
