**RE: Request for Observations – MUL240023**

Dear Sir/Madam,

MARA received an application from Iarnród Éireann (Irish Rail) on 17/06/2024 for a Maritime Usage Licence under the Maritime Area Planning Act 2021 for a maritime usage Licence under section 117 of the Maritime Area Planning Act 2021 along the East Coast from Dublin to Wicklow. They propose conducting geotechnical, geophysical, ecological and marine archaeological site investigations to inform design options for the proposed East Coast Railway Infrastructure Protection Projects (ECRIPP) required to defend long term sections of the Dublin to Rosslare coastal rail line from coastal erosion and flooding. The Licence application is for a period of 10 years.
