MARA received an application from the Department of Defence for a Maritime Usage Licence under the Maritime Area Planning Act 2021 for maintenance dredging at Haulbowline Naval Base, Co. Cork. The application is for maintenance dredging of the entrance channel and southern part of the Graving Dock and the deposit of dredged material 8km southeast of Roches Point.
