MARA has received an application from Codling Wind Park for a Maritime Usage Licence under the Maritime Area Planning Act 2021 for site surveys in Dublin/East Coast.

The site surveys are part of an ongoing survey schedule to undertake survey mobilisations at the proposed Licence Area to inform the location and detailed design of the proposed CWP OWF, export cable route, potential operations and maintenance base, potential land reclamation area at the potential onshore substation location, and additional buffer zones.
