RE: Request for Observations – MUL Reference: MUL240026

Dear Sir/Madam,

MARA has received an application from Uisce Éireann for a Maritime Usage Licence under the Maritime Area Planning Act 2021 to conduct a strategic modelling study of water currents and bathymetry off the Southeast coast of Ireland between Dungarvan, Co. Waterford and Greystones, Co. Wicklow.

The study requires the deployment of up to nine static Acoustic Doppler Current Profilers (ADCPs) at separate locations within the study area. Boat based ADCP, bathymetric surveys (multibeam and single beam) water sampling and tidal gauges will also be required.
