Dear Applicant,

I refer to your application to the Maritime Area Regulatory Authority (MARA) for the above referenced MAC.

Following a detailed assessment of your MAC application and your response dated 4 November 2025 and 5 November 2025 to the minded to notice dated 23 October 2025, and your response to MARA's request for further clarification dated 24 November 2025, please be advised that MARA has determined to grant you a MAC as per section 81(3)(b) of the Act for the proposed maritime usage, subject to conditions.

A copy of the MAC which includes the reasons for conditions is enclosed. The applicable MAC Levy is €0.00 annually. The levy for telecommunication cables will only be applied in respect of the portion of cables present in Ireland's territorial sea, i.e. within the 12nm zone.

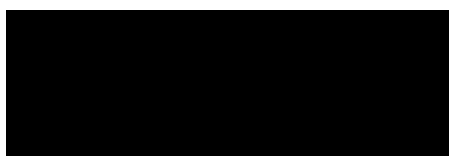
