I am writing to formally object to the proposed Bremore Port development by Bremore Ireland Port Designated Activity Company (BIPDAC), reference number MUL240011.

I have serious concerns regarding the scale and potential impact of this proposed development on the local environment, coastal ecosystem, nearby communities, infrastructure, and quality of life in the surrounding area.

In particular, I am concerned about:

The environmental impact on marine habitats, wildlife, and coastal biodiversity.

Increased traffic congestion, noise pollution, and air pollution affecting local residents.

The long-term visual and industrial impact on the coastline and surrounding landscape.

Potential risks to water quality, fisheries, and recreational coastal use.

The adequacy of the environmental assessments and long-term sustainability considerations.

The cumulative impact this development may have on existing infrastructure and local amenities.

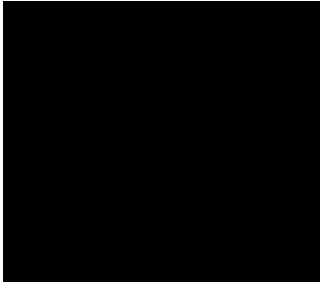
The potential damage to historical and archaeological sites at Bremore Head, including the loss of cultural heritage and the negative impact on an area of significant historical importance.

I believe the proposed development requires far greater scrutiny and consideration before any approval is granted. The potential negative consequences for the local community and environment appear to outweigh the projected benefits.

I respectfully request that MARA carefully consider these concerns and refuse permission for the proposed development under reference MUL240011.
