I wish to make a formal submission in strong objection to the above application (Ref: MUL240011) concerning site investigations for a proposed deep water development off the Bremore / Gormanston coastline.

1. The impact on the coastline on an unspoilt area of Natural Beauty and stunning views.
2. The Bremore / Gormanston coastline is an unspoilt and scenic stretch of coastline that is a public amenity and is a breathtakingly beautiful piece of Irish coastline.
3. The construction of an Irish Port would transform the whole area into an industrial zone and impact the environment. Pollution to the water , oil spills, rubbish build up, and damage to wildlife would occur, causing permanent visual, and environmental degradation on a huge scale.
4. Risks to marine life, the eco systems would be damaged , the water quality , chemical pollution and sediment disturbance from dredging.
