I am writing to you on behalf of Galetech Energy Developments (GED) to keep you updated about our proposed hydrogen storage project in the Celtic Sea.

We, under applicant name Allod Energy Ltd, submitted an application to the Maritime Area Regulatory Authority ("MARA") for a maritime usage licence under Section 117 of the Maritime Area Planning Act 2021 to undertake Marine geophysical site investigations in the Celtic Sea. MARA have now commenced a 30 day public consultation period.
