

Padel courts open day in Termonfeckin

Termonfeckin Tennis Club has announced the launch of their two new padel courts with an open day on Saturday 25th April. There are free coaching sessions and rackets available to all.

After the success of their four new tennis courts a year ago the club has now built two states of the art padel courts which are open to the public as a pay and play.

Club chairman Simon Linscheid said, "Padel tennis is the fastest growing sport in the world and is a great way to socialise with a sporting ac-

tivity."

He describes it as a great leveller so that people of all levels and athletic ability can play together and enjoy a game. This includes both families with kids, the older generation and competitive people. The courts themselves were made in Spain and they were installed in February for club members initially right beside the four existing hybrid clay courts.

You can join as a member for discounted rates or you can play anytime you like without joining by using the



Playtomic app to book courts and pay online.

Book for 60 or 90 minutes and all games are doubles.

The game uses balls similar to tennis and the rackets are a hard bat which can be bought as cheaply as €30 in

Decathlon or at Sports Direct in Drogheda. It's an incredibly enjoyable game that uses a mini tennis court and a plexiglass panoramic wall which you can play off similar to squash. The rules are simple and the game does not require high skill levels.

Everyone is welcome on Saturday the 25th of April from noon to 4pm at Termonfeckin Tennis Club in An Grianan (A92X9TF) to enjoy the brand-new facilities and have a go at the hottest new racquet sport to grace the courts!

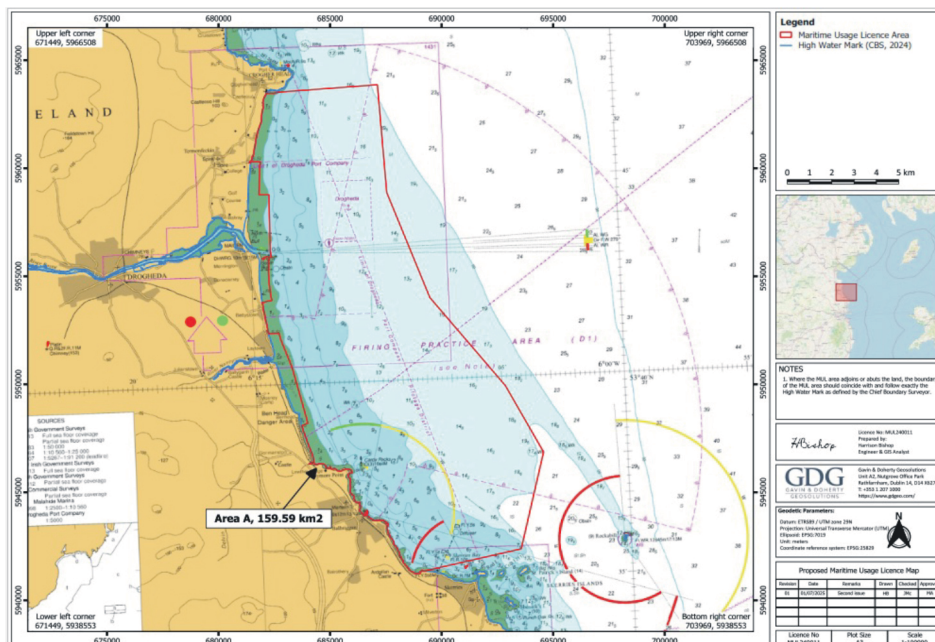

Invitation for public submissions on an application for a maritime usage licence and an appropriate assessment

Bremore Port, Bremore Ireland Port Designated Activity Company (BIPDAC) submitted an application to the Maritime Area Regulatory Authority ("MARA") for a maritime usage licence under section 117 of the Maritime Area Planning Act 2021 to undertake Schedule 7 (3): Marine environmental surveys for the purposes of site investigation or in support of an application under Part XXI of the Act of 2000. The licence application is for a period of 7 years.

MARA will then, as soon as practicable, carry out the appropriate assessment determination in accordance with Regulation 42 of the European Communities (Birds and Natural Habitats) Regulations 2011. After the determination, MARA will either grant, part grant or refuse the licence application.
