Re: Application for a Maritime Area Consent (MAC), Reference MAC20230024

Dear Applicant,

I refer to your application to the Maritime Area Regulatory Authority (MARA) for the above referenced MAC.

Following a detailed assessment of your MAC application and your response dated 15 July 2026 to the minded to notice dated 30 June 2026, please be advised that MARA has determined to part grant you a MAC as per section 81(3)(a) of the Act for the proposed maritime usage, subject to conditions as per section 81(3)(b) of the Act.

A copy of the MAC which includes the reasons for conditions is enclosed.

The annual MAC levy has been calculated based on the project type and MAC area in accordance with MARA's [MAC levy framework](#), as set out below.

All levies are indexed to the Harmonised Index of Consumer Prices (HICP), applied on an annual basis.

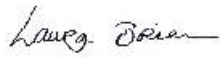
