### **Re: Application for a Maritime Area Consent (MAC), Reference MAC240059.**

Dear Applicant,

I refer to your application to the Maritime Area Regulatory Authority (MARA) for the above referenced MAC.

Following a detailed assessment of your MAC application and your response dated 09 January 2026 to the minded to notice dated 10 December 2025, please be advised that MARA has determined to part grant you a MAC as per section 81(3)(a) of the Act for the proposed maritime usage, subject to conditions as per section 81(3)(b) of the Act.

A copy of the MAC which includes the reasons for conditions is enclosed.

The applicable MAC Levy is €203,043.36 annually. This levy will be calculated annually based on the levy framework, applicable on the anniversary of the MAC.
