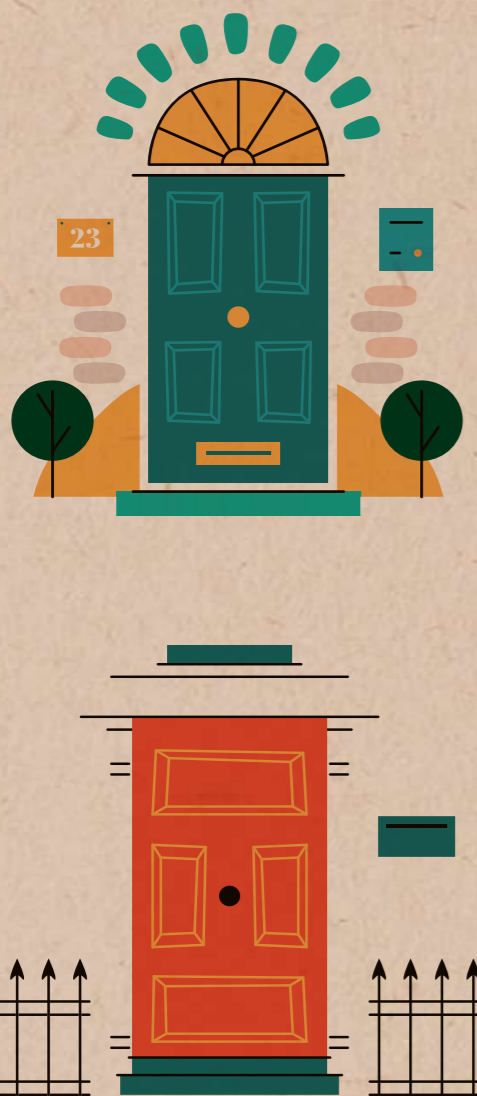

DUN LAOGHAIRE-RATHDOWN COUNTY COUNCIL. I, Luke Howard, intend to apply for Permission for development at the site at 17 Marley Drive, Rathfarham, Dublin D16 V66. The development will consist of: 1) demolition of the existing single-storey extension to the north side of the property, 2) construction of a new two-storey extension and a single-storey porch to the north side of the property, 3) alterations to the existing storage structure on the south side of the property, 4) construction of a new single-storey extension to the west (rear) of the property, 5) alterations to the external finishes of the existing main building, and all ancillary site works and landscaping required to facilitate and complete the development. 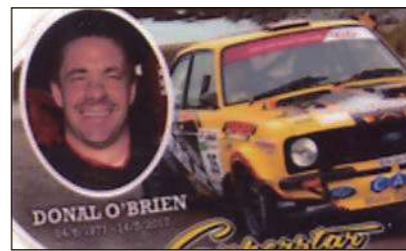

I wonder if these thoughts of mine you know.

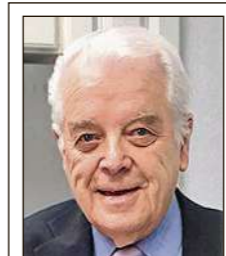
Across the span of years in yearning hope

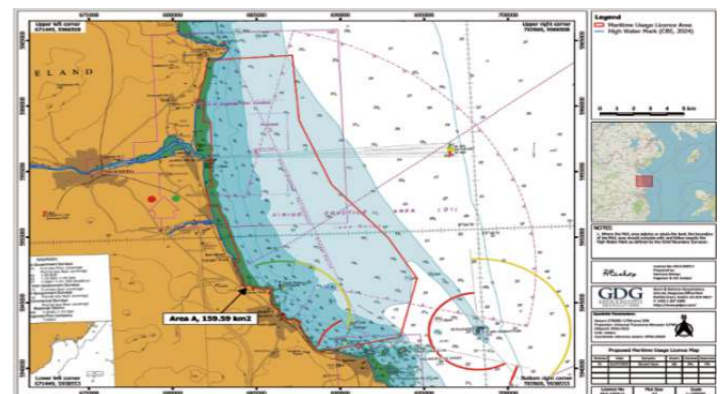

Invitation for public submissions on an application for a maritime usage licence and an appropriate assessment.
Bremore Port, Bremore Ireland Port Designated Activity Company (BIPDAC) submitted an application to the Maritime Area Regulatory Authority ("MARA") for a maritime usage licence under section 117 of the Maritime Area Planning Act 2021 to undertake Schedule 7 (3): Marine environmental surveys for the purposes of site investigation or in support of an application under Part XXI of the Act of 2000. MARA will then, as soon as practicable, carry out the appropriate assessment determination in accordance with Regulation 42 of the European Communities (Birds and Natural Habitats) Regulations 2011. After the determination, MARA will either grant, part grant or refuse the licence application.
