Notice in accordance with section 117(6)(a) of the Maritime Area Planning Act 2021 in respect of licence application reference LIC230007.

Dear Mr [REDACTED],

I refer to the application for a licence received by the Maritime Area Regulatory Authority (MARA) on 22<sup>nd</sup> January 2024.

On 1<sup>st</sup> October 2024 a determination was made by MARA, following screening under Regulation 42 of the European Communities (Birds and Natural Habitats) Regulations 2011 (S.I. 477 of 2011) that an appropriate assessment is required to be carried out in respect of the proposed maritime usage the subject of the application.
