Good day Paula,

After careful consideration the Marine Survey Office has no objection to the survey proposed in the application referenced in the subject line from a navigational safety perspective.

However, the following shall be noted;

- 1. The applicant shall ensure all appropriate measures are taken for the duration of any on-site activity and ensure any hazard to safe navigation created by the survey shall be easily identifiable to all mariners operating within or in the vicinity of the license area.
- All vessels engaged in the survey works must conform to Irish Certification standards and, the vessels shall be manned by suitably qualified personnel, additionally where equipment is carried an Irish Load line survey may be required. The applicant shall contact the Marine Survey Office Dublin for clarification.
- 3. The applicant shall, through consultation and agreement with the Department of Transport, Marine Survey Office arrange for the publication of a Marine Notice through the Maritime Safety Policy Division. Where a Marine Notice is published and subsequent changes to dates, area of or schedule of works, the licensee must inform MSPD of any relevant changes. Guidance on submitting a Marine Notice is available at Submit a Marine Notice
- 4. The Licensee shall engage directly with local stakeholders not limited to Dingle Harbour Master and local fishers and recreational organisations.
- 5. The promulgation and frequency of Navtex and radio broadcast warnings shall be agreed with the IRCG for the duration of the license period as deemed required.
- 6. The marking and lighting of any moored instruments shall be carried out in consultation with the Marine Survey Office and Commissioners of Irish Lights. Lighting and marking shall be compliant with International Association of Aids to Navigation (IALA) requirements. Information regarding the position of any markings creating a hazard to navigation shall be promulgated to the mariner via publication of a marine notice and all available means appropriate.
