I refer to the application for a licence received by the Maritime Area Regulatory Authority (MARA) on 28<sup>th</sup> June 2024.

On 6<sup>th</sup> January 2025 a determination was made by MARA, following screening under Regulation 42 of the European Communities (Birds and Natural Habitats) Regulations 2011 (S.I. 477 of 2011) that an appropriate assessment is required to be carried out in respect of the proposed maritime usage the subject of the application. For the purpose of the appropriate assessment, you are required to prepare a Natura Impact Statement in relation to the proposed maritime usage the subject of the licence application and submit it to MARA by 21<sup>st</sup> February, 2025. **In the event that you fail to submit the Natura impact statement by 21<sup>st</sup> February, 2025, (or any extension to this date permitted by MARA for good and sufficient reason) your licence application shall be deemed to be withdrawn in accordance with section 117(8) of the Maritime Area Planning Act 2021.**
