Dear Ms Staunton,

We refer to your correspondence dated 15/12/2025 confirming that the application will proceed to Stage 2 of the Appropriate Assessment process.

We further refer to the requirements set out in the Section 117(6)(b) notification, which requires the applicant to ensure that the prescribed Public Notice is published in one national newspaper and in the relevant local newspapers within a period of four weeks from the date of notification.

We request, in accordance with Section 117(6)(b), that MARA grant an extension of four additional weeks to the deadline for publication of the Public Notice for this application.

The original four-week period coincides with the Christmas and New Year holiday period, during which there is reduced availability of key staff due to annual leave. In addition, the preparation, coordination, and scheduling of newspaper advertisements, together with the requirement to prepare and finalise Irish-language translations of the notice, requires additional time, particularly given reduced capacity over the holiday period.

I trust that MARA will find this request reasonable in the circumstances and I would be grateful for written confirmation should the extension be approved. Please do not hesitate to contact me should any further information be required.
