Dear Sir/Madam,

MARA has received an application from Uisce Éireann for a Maritime Usage Licence under the Maritime Area Planning Act 2021 to conduct surveys to support a strategic modelling study of water currents within Galway Bay and the exposed coast extending northwest to Roundstone, County Galway and southwest to Loop Head Lighthouse, County Clare.

This project includes four phases: scoping, marine surveys, calibration and validation and scenario analysis. The marine surveys will collect the necessary hydrodynamic data. This data will then be used for the calibration of a hydrodynamic model to support a water quality assessment in Proposed Licence Areas.
