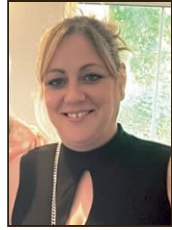


Softly in the morning, you heard a gentle call,

Invitation for Public Submissions on an Application for a Maritime Usage Licence and an Appropriate Assessment

Allod Energy Ltd has submitted an application to the Maritime Area Regulatory Authority ("MARA") for a maritime usage licence under Section 117 of the Maritime Area Planning Act 2021 to undertake Marine geophysical site investigations in the Celtic Sea. The duration requested in the licence application is for a period of 7 years.

A related Natura Impact Statement has been submitted with the above licence application. MARA will then, as soon as practicable, carry out the appropriate assessment determination in accordance with Regulation 42 of the European Communities (Birds and Natural Habitats) Regulations 2011. After the determination, MARA will either grant, part grant or refuse the licence application.
