TEMPORARY CLOSING OF PUBLIC ROADS

Pursuant to Section 75 of the Roads Act 1993, & Article 12 of the Roads Regulations 1994, notice is hereby given that Cork County Council proposes to temporarily close the following road for the period and reason specified below:-

Road Subject of Proposed Closure
N71- From Halfway Roundabout to Turn off for Cork Airport (R613)

Period of Proposed Closure
From 07:00hrs to 18:30hrs (Daily Closure) on Sunday, 14th June, 2026

Reason for Proposed Closure
To facilitate Drag Race Event

Alternative Routes
Traffic travelling in a Westerly direction on the N71, should turn left on to the slip road (L-2264). They should then turn left on to the R613 and drive in a Westerly Direction. They should proceed along the L2231 and drive through Halfway Village, turning left on to the R589 to rejoin the N71 at Halfway Roundabout.

Traffic travelling Eastbound on the N71 should turn left on to the R589 at Halfway Roundabout and turn right on to the L2231. They should proceed in an Easterly direction through Halfway Village and turn left on to the L2257 (Slip Road) to rejoin the N71.

Traffic Travelling Northbound on the R607, wishing to access locations east of the closed section of road should turn left on to the R589 at Halfway Roundabout then turn right on to the L2231. They should proceed in an Easterly direction and turn left on to the L2257 (Slip Road) to rejoin the N71.

Local Access will be maintained throughout the duration of the closure.

Objections to this proposed temporary road closure should be made in writing, to the undersigned, **quoting Ref. TRC: 91-2026, not later than 5pm on Wednesday, 27th May, 2026.** Telephone contact details should be included in the objection.

Port of Cork Company has submitted an application to the Maritime Area Regulatory Authority ("MARA") for a maritime usage licence under Section 117 of the Maritime Area Planning Act 2021 to undertake Marine environmental surveys for the purposes of site investigation or in support of an application under Part XXI of the Act of 2000.
