### **Non-Statutory Consultation**

#### **Maritime Usage Licence Application - Reference MUL250004**

The Maritime Area Regulatory Authority (MARA) has received an application from Celtic Seaweed Bath Products Ltd t/a VOYA. The application is a relevant foreshore authorisation (FS006269) which has been transferred to MARA in accordance with the provisions of Section 1E(5A) of the Foreshore Act 1933 (as amended). The application is for a Maritime Usage Licence under Section 117 of the Maritime Area Planning Act 2021 (as amended) (the MAP Act) to undertake Hand Harvesting of Fucus Sarratus Seaweed in Co. Sligo.

#### **Non-Statutory Consultation:**

3. Observations must be submitted **as soon as possible** and no later than **09/01/2026** (30 days + Bank Holidays, from the date of issue of this letter). Observations received by MARA after this deadline may not be considered.
4. All public body observations received by MARA will be published on the MARA website.

Where the public body does not intend to make observations to MARA regarding the above referenced maritime usage licence application, no response is required to this notice.
