## **Non-Statutory Consultation**

## Maritime Usage Licence Application - Reference MUL250020

Kilrush Maritime Ltd has submitted an application to the Maritime Area Regulatory Authority (MARA) for a Maritime Usage Licence under Section 117 of the Maritime Area Planning Act 2021 (the MAP Act) to undertake maintenance dredging of the approach channel to Kilrush Marina situated on the northern shore of the lower Shannon Estuary in Co. Clare.
