Maritime Usage Licence Application - Reference MUL240049, MUL250014, MUL250015, MUL250016 and MUL250017

Arramara Teoranta has submitted **five** applications to the Maritime Area Regulatory Authority (MARA) for a Maritime Usage Licence under Section 117 of the Maritime Area Planning Act 2021 (the MAP Act) to undertake the harvesting of seaweed, *Ascophyllum Nodosum* and *Fucus vesiculosus*, from the intertidal foreshore in sustainable quantities across five distinct locations in County Galway.
