Re MUL250022 Request for Observations

To whom it may concern,

Port of Waterford makes the following comments in relation to Uisce Eireann's application for a Maritime Usage Licence within the River Suir Estuary.

- Licence Holder to provide Port of Waterford with the proposed borehole locations overlaid on navigation chart BA 2046.
- Boreholes BH01 to BH04 are in close proximity to the navigation channel. The fairway, as described in the Port's [bye-laws](#), must be kept clear at all times.
- Licence Holder to give Port of Waterford a minimum of 30 days' notice in advance of commencement of works to allow for publication of a Local Notice to Mariners.
- All vessels engaged by the operator to be appropriately certified, insured, and manned by suitably qualified personnel.
- All vessels engaged by the operator will be subject to standard Port of Waterford protocols, licences, and charges.
- In the event of potential temporal overlap of any geophysical, seismic, and geotechnical activities, Port of Waterford's safety of navigation surveys will take priority.
- Port of Waterford to be consulted prior to deployment of any monitoring buoys. Any buoys deployed to have Statutory Sanction from Commissioners of Irish Lights.
- Port of Waterford to be consulted during planning phase of the new outfall.

The Port of Waterford makes this submission in order to ensure the safety of navigation. If you have any queries, please do not hesitate to contact me.
