ROADS ACT, 1993

TEMPORARY CLOSING OF PUBLIC ROADS

Pursuant to Section 75 of the Roads Act, 1993, & Article 12 of the Roads Regulations 1994, notice is hereby given that Cork County Council will close the following roads for the period and reason specified below:

Roads Subject of Closure

R907 (part) Main Street, Middleton, Co. Cork – from its junction with the L9403-1 Hospital Road Junction with the L3621-0 Broderick Street.

R627 (part) Connolly Street, Middleton, Co. Cork – from its junction with the R907 Main Street to its junction with Dickinson's Lane.

Period of Closure

From 06:00hrs to 20:30hrs (Daily Closure) on Sunday, 6th September 2026.

Reason for Closure

To facilitate the safe running of FEAST Festival.

Alternative Routes

Traffic travelling south along R626 take the L3288-0 and L3822-1 Northern Relief Road and onto N25.

Traffic Travelling north along R630 take the N25 and onto the L3288-0 and L3822-1 Northern Relief Road.

Traffic Travelling north through Middleton Town diverted at R907 Main Street onto L3621-0 Broderick Street, onto L3631-0 Riverside Way and onto R907/R626 Cork Road/Mill Road.

Traffic travelling south through Middleton Town diverted at R626 Mill Road onto L3631-0 Riverside Way, L3621-0 Broderick Street and onto R907 Youghal Road.

Traffic travelling south along R627 from Dungourney take the L7630-0 at Broomfield East. At Broomfield West take R626 to travel north or L3822-1 and L3288-0 Northern Relief Road to join the N25.

Traffic travelling south through Middleton Town from Dungourney diverted onto Drury's Avenue onto the L9403-1 The Green and onto the R907. Continue on the R907 to join the N25 or take the L3631-0 Riverside Way to travel southwest.

Local Access will not be maintained throughout the duration of the closure.

The Maritime Area Planning Act 2021 and the European Communities (Birds and Natural Habitats) Regulations 2011

Invitation for Public Submissions on an Application for a Maritime Usage Licence and an Appropriate Assessment

Port of Cork Company has submitted an application to the Maritime Area Regulatory Authority ("MARA") for a maritime usage licence under Section 117 of the Maritime Area Planning Act 2021 to undertake Marine environmental surveys for the purpose of site investigation or in support of an application under Part XXI of the Act of 2000. The duration requested in the licence application is for a period of 3 years.



A related Natura Impact Statement has been submitted with the above licence application. The licence application and the Natura Impact Statement are available for inspection on MARA's website <https://www.maritimeregulator.ie/application/mul260036> and at the following address by appointment– Maritime Area Regulatory Authority, 2nd Floor, Menapia House, Drinagh Business Park, Drinagh, Wexford, Y35 RF29.

Members of the public who wish to make a submission in writing to MARA on the licence application and the Natura Impact Statement may do so quoting MUL260036 by email to licence@mara.gov.ie or by post to Maritime Usage Licensing, Maritime Area Regulatory Authority, 2nd Floor, Menapia House, Drinagh Business Park, Drinagh, Wexford, Y35 RF29.

The closing date and time for a written submission to be received by MARA is 17.30 on 31/08/2026

MARA will then, as soon as practicable, carry out the appropriate assessment determination in accordance with Regulation 42 of the European Communities (Birds and Natural Habitats) Regulations 2011. After the determination, MARA will either grant, part grant or refuse the licence application.
