## Non-Statutory Consultation

### Maritime Usage Licence Application - Reference MUL240036MA

Eirgrid has submitted an application to the Maritime Area Regulatory Authority (MARA) for a material amendment under Section 125 of the Maritime Area Planning Act 2021 (the MAP Act) for proposed amendment to Specific Condition 32 of the existing MUL240036 for marine site investigations works for the Powering Up Offshore South Coast Project. The proposed Material Amendment seeks to amend Specific Condition 32 (relating to in-combination underwater noise effects). Specifically, the proposed Material amendment seeks to amend Condition 32 by reducing the coordination distance applied from 10km to 6km for specified marine survey activities at the south coast of Ireland.

#### **Non-Statutory Consultation:**
